## Fees:

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Dressage Sport Horse in hand \$15.00

Dressage tests (include critique for first test) \$20.00 each test to be judged, your first test of the day will include a 5 - 10 minute lesson with the judge schooling a low scoring portion of the test. This is a true schooling show. Get positive Constructive feedback, work with the judge improving your test and then ride a second test or ride a different test. Rider's choice.

Grounds Fee \$15.00 per horse. You are welcome to bring young horses for schooling onsite without entering a class. Just bring Coggins and pay Grounds fee.

Stall Fee \$30.00 (includes use of wash stall for day)

Contact Castle Farm for stall availability before sending your entry fee

Late Fee \$10.00 if received after the closing date

USEF rules for dressage apply; know them.

USEF approved helmets are mandatory for all riders at all times when mounted.

**No Dogs Allowed**

**Ample Parking** with 3 entrances/exits – Large field parking for cars and trailers to the right of driveway entrance. Exit is at opposite end of field back to the driveway allowing trailers to circle easily in and out. Water hook up with hose close to trailer parking and warm up area.

Liability releases must be signed once per year, since insurance is through CFA not PVDA which is the reason you do not have to be a PVDA member to participate.

## Awards:

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\$100 **Cash** to the High Point Rider of the Day (sport horse in hand and lead line excluded)

Ribbons are awarded in every class - first through sixth place.

A Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbon is awarded for each level: Intro, Training, First, Second and above, only if there are at least 3 qualifying riders at the level. To qualify, the horse/rider team must ride at least 2 tests at the same level. The test scores will be averaged to determine the Champion and Reserve Champion. Therefore, it is possible that the Champion at the Level may not have the highest score, but will be the most consistent high scorer.

The **Champion at each level will receive a free dressage test for a future show \$20 value** that can be used at any of Castle Farm's future shows, **ONLY** if there are at least 4 qualifying riders at that level. Just submit coupon with your next entry.

Year End Awards will be given at the last show of the year. To be eligible, the same horse/rider combination must compete in 3 of the 4 shows at the same level. Awards will be handed out at the end of the show day during the October year end show. If winners are not present, they will be notified and can pick up awards anytime at Castle Farm. All show results and year end awards will be posted on our website. [www.CastleFarmAndalusians.com](http://www.CastleFarmAndalusians.com). For year end awards, all of your scores at a given level will be averaged except your one lowest score will be dropped. Year End Champion Rosettes are awarded for the highest average at Intro, Training Level, First Level and second and Above as long as at least 3 qualifying riders are eligible by competing in at least 3 shows.
